**...as defined by the young person.**

**For a young person to be eligible for Household Network they need to be:**

- Aged between 16-25
- At risk of homelessness OR currently transient, coupled with:
  - Currently experiencing drug and/or alcohol issues, and/or
  - Experiencing mental health issues, and/or
  - Being LGBTIQA+, and/or
  - Being First Nations
